





PsiSwitch

Using Sensitive Inanimate Physical Systems as Targets of Intentional Influence

This project seeks to demonstrate that it is possible to control devices at a distance solely by mental means. There are ample examples of conventional brain-computer "telepathy" interfaces, such as Facebook's Building 8 and Elon Musk's Neurolink. Unlike these existing neuroscience techniques which decode brain electrical activity, PsiSwitch would operate via direct mind-matter interactions without regard to distance in space or time, and without relying on electromagnetic detecting or signaling. Such a switch would be the basis for communications and control systems that could operate in contexts where conventional methods cannot — such as deep space, deep sea, and through time.


The exciting news: All of the systems tested above show evidence for mind-matter interactions. While the absolute magnitude of the effects are small and the direction of influence is not reliably predictable, our preliminary studies provide enough promising results to continue along this line of research.

Our ongoing research is investigating ways of amplifying these effects to make them more reliable and robust. To that end, we have created a global online platform to more easily test multiple targets and operators simultaneously. Additionally, we are building a framework for performing online experiments where participants mentally attempt to influence various targets such as random number generators.

THREE MAIN FACTORS BEING MEASURED:

Subjective experience of interconnectedness

Extended human capacities (psi)

Levels of innovation, well-being, and attitudes toward and experience of transformation

THREE RESEARCH QUESTIONS BEING ASKED:

What, if any, relationship exists between these three factors?

Are these factors affected by different practices?

Do certain participant characteristics influence the factors or the relationships between them?

EARLY ANALYSIS

While the study is ongoing and growing in data points, some early analyses have been revealing.

When we look at the relationship of the three factors with the data we have today, we see that a person's subjective experience of interconnectedness has a strong positive relationship with multiple factors, increasing with: 1) more years of education, 2) the personality trait of "agreeableness," 3) a sense of openness, and 4) belief in and experience with the paranormal. Their sense of interconnectedness is also positively related to their well-being.


The remote viewing task also shows interesting results. These tasks measure a person's ability to describe or give details about a target that is not normally available to our traditional five senses due to distance, time, or shielding. We found that higher remote viewing scores are related to the trait of "positive affect," or a

person's propensity to experience positive emotions and interact with others and with life's challenges in a positive way.

Moving from Pilot Phase to Formal Study:

We anticipate completing the pilot phase of this study in mid 2020. We will then analyze the data and begin to develop particular hypotheses that we can test in the formal phase of the IONS Discovery Lab. Additionally, we are translating the survey into additional languages, starting with Spanish and Chinese, to further broaden the scope of the study.

ADVANCING THE FIELD

IONS Channeling Research Program: 2016 to Present

We hypothesize that, at some level, all people have the ability to access information and energy not limited by space and time, and that the way in which we access this and express it can be conceived as our noetic signature – both having similarities with others and yet unique to each individual.

Channeling is a term often used for many aspects of this experience.

The channeling experience exists on a spectrum from very commonplace intuition or gut hunches to the rarer trance channeling where the channeler believes a discarnate being is directly communicating to the listener by accessing the channeler's body. The channeling phenomenon has been present throughout history, and in many cultures, gathered in texts and anecdotal evidence.

What Can Science Tell Us?

Case studies and experimental evidence document that some information retrieved through channeling is veridical, useful, and otherwise not available through germane circumstances. For example, Edgar Cayce was a trance channel that had a number of his predictions and medical diagnoses verified, and for decades the U.S. Government funded StarGate, a parapsychology research center in which the attributes of psychic abilities were investigated.

Given the length of time channeling has existed among humans, we feel it is important to understand more about these phenomena. By leveraging the scientific method to explore the validity of channeling, we may learn more about how our consciousness transcends our physical bodies, or the nonlocal nature of our consciousness. While some research has been conducted elsewhere, until we launched this program, there were no large, coordinated efforts to answer essential questions on channeling.

Building on decades of previous work at IONS and elsewhere, the IONS Channeling Research Program aims to answer six research questions:

- 1. What do we already know from published and unpublished resources about channeling?
- 2. How common is nonlocal consciousness reception and what are its characteristics?
- 3. How does channeling work?
- 4. Are there defining characteristics of someone who is able to receive information more easily?
- 5. Can we verify the information?
- 6. Is the content useful?

Findings From Our Research

For the last four years, the IONS science team has successfully implemented a comprehensive research program on channeling, using rigorous and systematic methods and resulting in numerous peer-reviewed papers. Our biggest findings include that the channeling phenomenon is common, not reflective of mental health pathology, and has specific and definable characteristics including the positive impact on one's life.

Through our research, we have gained an understanding of how channeling might work, including learning from channeled material many of the qualities that make a channel a channel. We are currently verifying these findings through continued study of biological or genetic involvement. We have also demonstrated that channels can receive verifiable information that they could not have access to otherwise and aim to replicate these findings. Through this holistic and rigorous program, IONS is demystifying channeling, bringing a scientific understanding to a long-practiced and barely understood human phenomena.

To date, we have published over a dozen peer-reviewed papers from this program. We will continue to explore the mechanisms by which the ability to reveal information and energy not limited by space and time manifests in individuals, and how we can harness these abilities to expand our sense of interconnection.

New Patent Provides Non-Invasive Method to Study Gene Expression

Using a process that's as easy as gargling, researchers can now gather data to understand how various stimuli activate gene expression in humans. Through a non-invasive method newly patented by IONS Scientist Dr. Garret Yount, study participants can now provide a sample of their RNA by swishing a mouthwash solution for 30 seconds, a painless and preferable alternative to drawing blood with a needle.

Exceptional Healers Pilot Study

This past year we embarked on one of the largest and most complex research projects in our history, the Exceptional Healers Pilot Study. Over several months, we hosted 17 subtle energy practitioners from a wide variety of modalities. Each practitioner spent a week conducting healing sessions with a total of nearly 200 participants seeking relief from the pain of Carpal Tunnel Syndrome.

Phase 1 Is Complete

In this study we focused on people who experience hand or wrist pain. Participants came to our campus and completed a number of questionnaires and physiological tests, along with a 30-minute energy healing session in our electromagnetically shielded chamber. Intake data included the clients' pre-session expectations about energy healing and their current and past pain symptoms. The physiological tests included heart rate variability and

The basic aims of the study were threefold:

- 1. To determine the feasibility and preliminary effects of a study of this type
- 2. To evaluate the psychobiological mechanisms by which subtle energy practitioners achieve health outcomes
- 3. To discover the mechanisms by which subtle energy is transmitted from practitioner to receiver

synchrony (between participant and practitioner), wrist nerve conduction velocity, and gene activity via collection of salivary samples using Dr. Yount's newly patented method. Additionally, we looked at environmental factors through potential changes in quantum noise, in the magnetic field, and with water samples which were analyzed for changes in evanescence, pH, and conductivity.

While we are still analyzing the vast data collected, preliminary findings demonstrate that the pilot study was a resounding success. Perhaps most importantly, the majority of clients reported a reduction in pain from before to after the session, and continued to maintain that pain reduction at the three-week return visit. This demonstrates that this type of study is indeed feasible to pursue on a larger scale.



Regarding the psychobiological mechanisms by which subtle energy is transmitted, the study found that overall heart rate and respiration decreased during the session, while heart rate variability and synchrony increased, indicating greater coherence between healer and participant as the session progressed.

One of the most dramatic results was an environmental measurement using the Quantum Number Generator. It recorded significant deviations in background entropy during the healing sessions as compared to control periods, suggesting that the healing sessions caused entropic ripples in spacetime.

IONS IN THE WORLD

Engaging in Noetic Conversations with His Holiness Dalai Lama

The meeting was in collaboration with the Center for Contemplative Science and Compassion-Based Ethics at Emory University and was also attended by a delegation of World Economic Forum Young Global Leaders.

Expansion of IONS Partnership with the Octave Institute in China

Members of the IONS team traveled to China three times in 2019 to expand the partnership with the Octave Institute, while members of the Octave team traveled to California in July to participate in the IONS Conference, with founder Fred Tsao serving as a keynote speaker.

IONS CEO Claire Lachance and scientist Dr. Garret Yount participated in the Quantum Leadership Program at Octave's Sangha Retreat Center in Suzhou in April and July respectively. In November, Claire Lachance and members of the Science Team — Dr. Helané Wahbeh, Dr. Arnaud Delorme, and Dr. Garret Yount — were speakers and group moderators at Octave's AT ONE Conference and Festival, addressing the theme "New Paradigm: New Era of Well-Being."

Transpersonal Psychologists Explore Eco-Spiritual Transformation And Channeling

In April 2019, Director of Research Dr. Helané Wahbeh gave a presentation on IONS channeling research to approximately 350 professionals at the Association of Transpersonal Psychology, building on ATP's commitment to fostering practices and perspectives that will lead to a conscious, co-evolution of society.

The Largest Gathering of Parapsychology Professionals from Around the World

IONS hosted the Parapsychology Association at our Earthrise Campus, the largest international professional organization of scientists and scholars engaged in the study of extended human capacities. IONS Chief Scientist Dr. Dean Radin, joined by our Science Team, taught participants the techniques and standards necessary to achieve rigorous, peer-reviewed scientific publications in this domain.

IONS Research Expanding Into International, Interdisciplinary Fields

In June, IONS Scientist Dr. Arnaud Delorme spoke at The Science of Consciousness 2019 conference in Interlaken, Switzerland, highlighted by Nobel Prize in Physics winner Roger Penrose on Artificial Intelligence, Computation, Physical Law, and Consciousness.

Helané Wahbeh, ND, MCR, Director of Research

Helané Wahbeh is the Director of Research at the Institute of Noetic Sciences and an adjunct assistant professor in the Department of Neurology at Oregon Health & Science University. Dr. Wahbeh is clinically trained as a naturopathic physician and research trained with a Master of Clinical Research and two post-doctoral research fellowships. She has published on and spoken internationally about her studies on complementary and alternative medicine, mind-body medicine, stress, and posttraumatic stress disorder and their relationships to physiology, health, and healing.

Dean Radin, PhD, Chief Scientist


Dean Radin, PhD, is Chief Scientist at the Institute of Noetic Sciences and Associated Distinguished Professor at the California Institute of Integral Studies. Before joining the research staff at IONS in 2001, he held appointments at AT&T Bell Labs, Princeton University, University of Edinburgh, and SRI International. Dr. Radin is author or coauthor of hundreds of technical and popular articles, some 100 peer-reviewed journal articles, four dozen book chapters, and four best-selling books. He has given over 500 invited presentations and interviews for government, military, business, scientific, and popular groups around the world.





Arnaud Delorme, PhD, Scientist

Arnaud Delorme, PhD, is a CNRS principal investigator in Toulouse, France, a faculty member at the University of California, San Diego, and a Scientist at the Institute of Noetic Sciences. He is a long-term Zen meditator, and has taught in India on the neural correlates of conscious experience in a Master's degree program for the Birla Institute of Technology.



Garret Yount, PhD, is a Scientist at the Institute of Noetic Sciences. Dr. Yount's primary interest is bridging molecular neurobiology with aspects of consciousness and the nonmaterial mind. He began his formal studies in consciousness research with a small grant from the Institute of Noetic Sciences in 1995, which allowed him to work with biofield practitioners and spiritual healers in the laboratory.





Loren Carpenter, Scientist

Loren Carpenter revolutionized the entire film industry through inventing rendering and modeling algorithms for image synthesis and visual effects. In 2001, he and two colleagues were awarded the only Oscar statuettes ever given for computer science. He recently transitioned from his position as Senior Research Scientist in Disney/Pixar's research division to that of a Scientist at IONS.

The Possibility Accelerator Formula

In 2019, we offered Conference attendees a program called The Possibility Accelerator, designed to support them in deepening and embodying the wisdom that was arising for them at our Conference, and provide them with practical tools they could take back into their lives.

Focusing on the concept of a "moonshot," an ambitious effort to achieve the seemingly impossible, we developed a 60 page Conference workbook that asked questions like: what bold, audacious, future do we want to work for? What transformations do we want to see for ourselves, our families, our communities or the world at large? In the weeks following the Conference we delivered a six-part web-based workshop to almost 200 people, nearly 20% of all conference attendees.

This pilot program proved successful in inspiring people and activating them towards achieving their moonshots. We are currently developing the program for a more formal launch in 2020.

FINANCIAL STEWARDSHIP


The IONS team continues to strengthen financial performance and stewardship, with three straight years of net income growth and the launch of the IONS 50 initiative to proactively address deferred maintenance and expanded utilization of our campus. 
